Whether you choose to explore the hidden gems of the city, ethnic neighborhoods, or try a cuisine of your choice for dining you will have time to enjoy on your own. Tomorrow morning, we invite you to enjoy an included, comprehensive sightseeing tour of New York City's "MUST SEE" attractions, led by a local guide.

Later we board the **Celebrity Summit** and set sail along the Northeast coast. There will be a day in historic **Boston** and another in small but sophisticated, historic **Portland** before we enjoy one of the best attractions in the Northeast . . . **Bar Harbor**, nestled on the east side of **Mt. Desert Island** and gateway to **Acadia National Park**. Following Quebec City, we sail North to **Corner Brook** home to the Captain James Cook Historic site and incredible scenery.
