Our journey will start with overnight flights from the Cleveland Airport to Athens, Greece. After checkin at our centrally located hotel in **Athens**, the day will end with a Welcome Dinner at a local restaurant. We'll start our journey off right with a glass of wine or beer and a toast to the discoveries of this trip! You will unpack and pack once while we are in Athens. This is a small group tour.

All the "must see and must do" attractions are on our agenda as we enjoy Athens on our private coach with a local guide. Following the visits to the **Acropolis**, **Acropolis Museum**, and famous historical **Agora**, we will top the day off with a local dining experience.

The Cruise Itinerary Aboard the Celebrity Infinity

After leaving Athens with unforgettable memories, we board **Celebrity Cruise Line's** ship **INFINITY** for our **10-night Greece and Turkey Cruise.** Again, only unpacking & packing once for the rest of the journey!

The itinerary includes **Volos** (Greece), **Ephesus** (Kusadasi-Turkey), **Istanbul** (Turkey 2 days), the Iconic Islands of **RHODOS**, **SANTORINI** & **MYKONOS** are all on our ports of call. Note that these historical sights involve uneven surfaces when walking, climbing stairs and standing. Comfortable shoes are a MUST.

We are excited to share that all our guests will be accommodated in **CONCIERGE CLASS CABINS with a Verandah on Deck # 8** featuring dedicated Concierge Service, luxurious cabin amenities and more and . . yes, we included the **Classic Beverage Package** for the duration of the cruise to include your alcoholic/nonalcoholic beverages.

A 6:00 PM dinner time has been requested for our group while onboard. Smart Casual wear is recommended throughout this trip. Shorts and ball caps are not allowed at shrines or religious sites. Ladies are required to have their heads covered at most religious sites.

A Little About the Ports:

Volos:

This beautiful, coastal town is the third largest port city (after Piraeus and Thessaloniki) in the country's largest agricultural region , located approximately 200 miles north of Athens.

In addition to the features included during our stay in Athens, Greece, we have the following **private arrangements** for you in Turkey.

Ephesus - port city Kusadasi:

Included Private Full Day Excursion and Lunch

A full day of sightseeing with a private coach and a local guide in **Kusadasi** visiting **Ephesus Archeological** site and the **House of Virgin Mary**. One of the 7 Churches of Asia addressed in the Book of Revelation and one of the 7 wonders of the world "**Temple of Artemis**". The Gospel of St. John may have been written there.

Following our visit, you will be treated to lunch in the historic delightful village of Sirince (meaning cute). Originally it was called Cirkince (means ugly).

Next – Istanbul Day #1:

Included Private Full Day Excursion, Lunch and Dinner

A city where the old and the new are blended, a city that is home to almost 20 million people and indescribable, challenging traffic. A city spread across two continents, Europe, and Asia.

Our Full Day excursion with a private coach and local guide will start following your breakfast on board.

Don't miss the ship's **grand entrance** from the **Sea of Marmara into the Bosphorus Straight** early in the morning. Our visits today include the **Blue Mosque**, constructed between 1609 and 1617 with stunning blue tiles and six minarets and **St. Sophia** which stands for Holy Wisdom. It was the principal church of the Byzantine Empire. Our next stop is **Topkapi Palace** where construction started in 1460 and served as the administrative center of the Ottoman Empire until 1856.

A change of pace takes us to a food tasting at the **Spice Bazaar** (also known as Egyptian Bazaar, built in 1664), then to **Pera Palace** for a light lunch with some surprising treats (just like in Murder on the Orient Express). Pera Palace Hotel which opened in 1895, was the first building in the Ottoman Empire to be powered by electricity, (other than the Ottoman Palaces) with hot running water and electric lift.

We will end our day with another included dining experience at a traditional Kebab restaurant and a glass of wine or a beer on us.

Istanbul Day #2:

Included Private Full Day Excursion, Light Lunch and Dinner

Today, we are going to take it easy and have some fun since we learned a lot about the history of the destination yesterday. Let's all meet again after breakfast on board. This time, we will experience the city and its skyline, from the Bosphorus, on a boat ride, followed with a visit to the world-famous **Grand Bazaar**. It is known as one of the oldest covered markets in the world with 61 covered streets and over 3000 stores, often regarded as one of the first shopping malls of the world. We will grab a light lunch in the area.

It's now time to say *Farewell* to this part of our journey and celebrate by having another traditional dinner at another local venue. *Cheers to all*!!

As the second half of the cruise starts, you may choose to explore the islands of **Rhodes**, **Santorini and Mykonos** at your own pace or book one of the excursions offered onboard. Whether you choose to take a leisurely walk with your camera or take a short excursion we know you will love these intriguing and beautiful islands.

Rhodos:

Has been shaped by Romans, Byzantine, Genoese, Ottoman, and Italian influences. It's Medieval Old Town with winding cobbled streets of the walled city is breathtaking. In ancient days, Rhodes was famous worldwide for the **Colossus of Rhodes**, which was one of the 7 wonders of the world.

Santorini:

This crescent shaped island and its neighboring islands are the remnants of a largely submerged dormant volcano, which was responsible for one of the largest eruptions in recorded history around 3600 years ago. Many may recall pictures of this island with its blue domed rooftops. A funicular ride is your basic pattern to get to the town center from the pier or MAYBE YOU WILL WANT TO EXPERIENCE THE ALTERNATIVE WAY TO TRAVEL, ON A MULE OR DONKEY.

Mykonos:

A lively island day and night with its 16th century windmills. The best and the only way to get around the island is to walk. The streets may be convoluted but getting lost in them is part of the fun.
